An instrumental music student is defined as one who:

- Has lessons on the instrument for the full year* (or had the intention to when they enrolled)
- Is formally assessed on that instrument (i.e. receives a written report)
- Participates in at least one **ensemble** *in addition to* weekly lessons for the full school year*

** or as much of the year as is practicable for beginner students*

A student who meets any of the following criteria will **not** be counted as an instrumental music student:

- Participates in a class band for one semester (or less) and does not continue with the instrument beyond that point
- Has lessons each week, but is not in an ensemble
- Doesn't perform
- Is not formally assessed for instrumental music

Definition of an ensemble:

- NOT the lesson group
- consists of at least four students
- runs for the full school year
- directed by a teacher (i.e. not just a band 'jamming' at lunchtimes on their own)
- is formally assessed, either in its own right or as a component of the instrumental music subject report
- performs at least once a semester
